YOUNG BLOOD & FOETAL PARTS

Trafficking the New Fountains of Youth

Movie stars and celebrities have long pursued ways to prolong their youthful looks to stay relevant in their careers. In a competitive “meat market,” looking young is far more important than being healthy, which is why many celebs and wealthy people do some strange things to ward off aging as much and as long as possible.

Sadly, in what sounds like a horror movie plot, some of those strange things involve harvesting parts of aborted fetuses and the blood of the young.

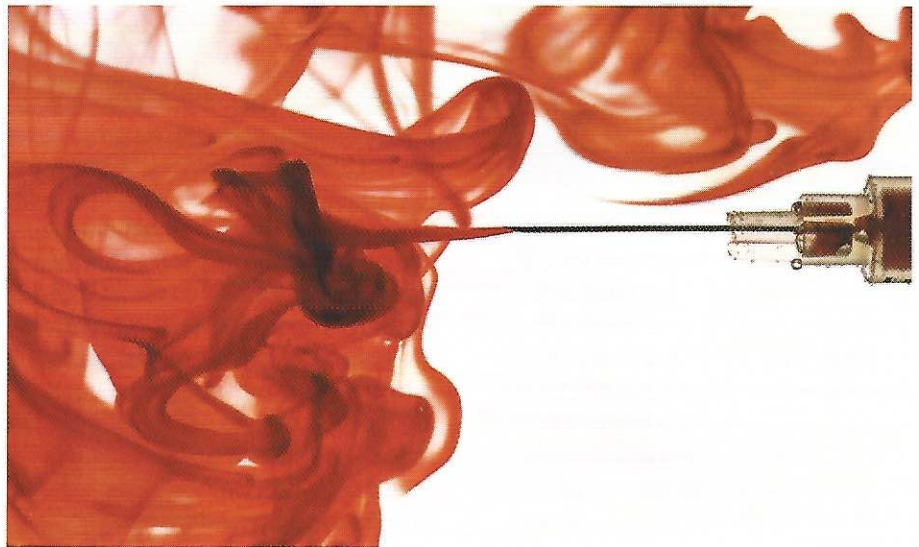
A June 2017 article in *Allure* magazine, “People are Injecting Themselves with Blood From Teens and We’re So Scared,”¹ reported on the use of PRP – platelet-rich plasma – in skincare to improve skin tone, fight wrinkles, and even promote hair growth.

You can use your own blood, but using the blood of someone younger can supposedly restore youth. That was what motivated the biotech start-up company Ambrosia.

The company supplied blood transfusions from young people to the lucky few who could cough up \$8,000 per treatment without any published evidence to support its claims. According to *Allure*: “Participants in the trials have seen lower levels of cancer-causing carcinoembryonic antigens, lower cholesterol, and a lowered Alzheimer’s risk.” There were no control groups to determine its effectiveness, but that didn’t stop 100 people from signing up for the initial run.

By the end of 2018, Ambrosia had opened clinics in five US cities until the following year when the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued a general warning to consumers that plasma infusions from young people provided “no proven clinical benefit” against ageing or its diseases and that there were risks.

A 2020 piece in the UK’s *Guardian*,

ian, “Could ‘Young’ Blood Stop Us Getting Old?,” reported on several start-ups working with a technique called parabiosis.

“In the early 2000s a group of scientists at Stanford University, California, revived a grisly procedure used in the 1950s known as parabiosis. They paired living mice, young with old, peeled back their skin and stitched together their sides so the two animals shared the same blood circulatory system. A month later, they found signs of rejuvenation in the muscles and livers of the old mice. The findings, published in 2005, turned the minds of scientists, entrepreneurs and the public to the potential of young blood to rejuvenate ageing people.”²

The goal was to identify factors

in plasma that change with age and create therapies that either supplement what’s beneficial in young blood or to inhibit what’s detrimental in old. Many of the labs that started work in 2020 are now onto clinical testing.

We now jump to August 2022 and a *ScienceAlert* story, “Scientists Gave Young Mice the Blood of Old Mice, Then Things Got Weird.”³ Researchers performed an experiment where they infused the blood of older mice aged 22-24 into three-month-old male mice and found evidence of tissue aging and “decreased maximal twitch force and significantly shorter rates of force development and relaxation during contractions.” The young mice also exhibited faster onset of fatigue and ran shorter dis-

tances on a treadmill than a control group. When the experiment was reversed and older mice were given younger blood, "lipids and fibrosis and fatigue declines and muscle endurance increased."

Circulating into this mix of real scientific breakthroughs and underground start-up experiments are dark conspiracies about the stealing of children's and babies' blood for anti-aging treatments.

One such theory is about elites using adrenochrome, a chemical compound linked to adrenaline that many claim is extracted from little children during torture and distress. It is injected into the bloodstream of the rich and famous to keep them 'young'. While there is no proof of this, it's not hard to see how such a terrifying claim might be made when the blood of children is now such a highly coveted commodity. Not just blood but stem cells and "preborn puree" from aborted fetuses.

Yes, it just got a whole lot weirder, only this time it's real.

As far back as 2005, people were flying to places like Ecuador, Russia, and Ukraine to receive stem cell makeovers to fight various blood disorders and Parkinson's Disease, but also because the same treatments cleared up wrinkles and restored youthful looks.

A 2005 piece for *The Independent*, "Britons Fly Abroad for Stem-Cell Makeovers," reported on the claims that stem cells taken from lab-created embryos were the "new fountain of youth," according to Barnett Suskind, chief executive of the Institute of Regenerative Medicine (IRM) in Barbados.⁴

"You think better, sleep better, look better. Your quality of life improves and your libido certainly improves," Suskind stated. The Barbados clinic's claims were based upon the idea that the process used for improving disease markers could also be used for cosmetic purposes.

Stem cells taken from aborted fetuses were gestated for six to 12 weeks and then injected into a patient's arm. The new cells supposedly searched out damaged, dead cells and repaired and replaced them. Despite others in the scientific

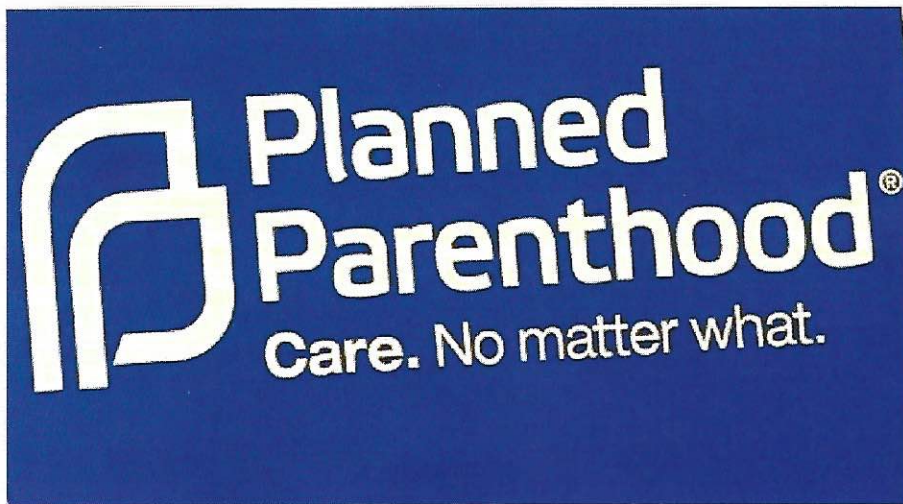
community warning that Suskind's claims were not based on scientific evidence and that it could be dangerous, people paid the big bucks and got the injections, despite ethical concerns about using tissue from aborted fetuses. That didn't seem to matter as long as they could look and feel younger.

A shocking report published by *Physicians For Life*, "Stem Cells, Abortion, Baby Parts & the Ukraine," alleged that the IRM in Barbados imported aborted baby parts from Ukraine and liquefied them into a "preborn puree" to be injected into the arms and body organs of their customers.⁵

These treatments could run as high as \$25,000 per session and

fueled a "horrific industry" that reveals the IRM is "just a small part of a worldwide network of trafficking in human stem cells and organs – not only from embryos and fetuses but from long-term aborted babies and even newborn babies." The report also found that these clinics, numbering around 50, refused to join the International Stem Cell Forum, a board designed to regulate ethical stem cell research.

Many of the clinics covered in the *Physicians For Life* investigation reportedly engaged in torturous and horrific practices, such as one in China that drilled holes in the skulls of ALS (Lou Gehrig's disease) patients and injected foetal stem cells directly into their brains. Companies like Bio-

mark International in the US charged patients \$21,000 to treat them with foetal stem cells, regardless of their disease. The operators later fled the country after they were shut down by the FDA.

The *Physicians For Life* report also covers disturbing allegations of exploiting poor women in Ukraine for foetuses. Given the 1.2 million annual abortions in Ukraine, they found “that the foetal and embryonic stem cell and organ trade in this one country is worth multiple hundreds of millions – perhaps even billions – of dollars annually, even if only a small percentage of the aborted babies are used for research and harvesting.”

In 2005, Council of Europe investigators found that hundreds of newborn babies had been stolen from their mothers in the Ukrainian cities of Kyiv and Kharkov. In each case, the mothers were poor and powerless and were told that their babies had simply died or were “gone.” Investigators exhumed many of the missing babies. Their arms and legs had been severed, their chest cavities were empty, and their brains missing. Investigator Tatyana Zakharova said, “They were like gutted rabbits.”

ABORTION INDUSTRY

The controversial use of aborted babies continues as part of the growing demand for young blood and foetal parts. Industries are popping up eager to satisfy that demand while defying regulation and external

investigation. The desire for these anti-aging treatments leaves us to wonder where all this young blood and foetal parts derive.

In the United States, one major supplier is allegedly the biggest provider of abortions, Planned Parenthood, which was caught on a hidden video camera admitting to harvest-

ing and selling aborted foetuses, as well as during legal testimony in court.

According to a 2020 story for LifeNews.com, one procurement manager for Advanced Bioscience Resources (ABR) admitted that they harvested aborted baby body parts from Planned Parenthood facilities in Southern California.⁶ It was confirmed in court that some aborted baby bodies are fully intact at birth, and some even able to breathe independently.

Dr Deborah Nucatola, former

senior director of medical services for Planned Parenthood, was caught in a Center for Medical Progress video talking over lunch about how she “crushes” the heads of unborn babies to better harvest their body parts.⁷

The Center for Medical Progress released another shocking video on 30 June 2020 featuring unsealed clips from Planned Parenthood and abortion industry officials’ sworn deposition testimony, with disturbing descriptions of infants born alive and either harvested for organs or left to die inside abortion clinics.

TIP OF THE ICEBERG

On a global scale, who knows how many companies are today engaging in the harvesting of foetuses and young blood to satisfy the lust for youth of the rich and powerful? At tens of thousands of dollars per injection, it’s a massive and profitable market that could make the blood and bodies of aborted foetuses, babies, and children worth their weight in solid gold.

Child trafficking isn’t just about sex with children but also the stealing of the very young’s dead and alive body parts to satisfy the narcissistic whims of wealthy adults afraid to look their age. ■

at award shows and in every video and signs and symbols...” exclaimed Gibson. He went on to add that Hollywood is overflowing with “satanic paedophiles.”⁹

Sadly, it’s not the first time Satanism has been associated with child sex trafficking and paedophilia.

DOWN THE TRAFFICKING RABBIT HOLE

It’s a fact that victims have been coerced into sex with entertainment bigwigs, icons, and moguls, and no doubt many of the allegations made by child stars hold truth. Rumours run rampant that the elites have secure sources of child supply in the billion-dollar sex trafficking trade. “Agents” procure that supply of young boys and girls.

Two names that most come to mind are Ghislaine Maxwell and Jeffrey Epstein. Epstein’s story exploded into the public eye in 2005 when the powerful financier was charged and convicted for sexually abusing a 14-year-old girl. In 2008 he was convicted of procuring a child for prostitution and of soliciting a prostitute. Then, in July 2019, he was arrested on federal charges of sex

trafficking minors in the states of New York and Florida.

His long-time partner Ghislaine Maxwell was found guilty in 2021 of child sex trafficking connected to Epstein. She was sentenced to 20 years in jail. Epstein died in jail in what the medical examiner rules as suicide by hanging, but circumstances were disputed by Epstein’s lawyers who believe he was killed, perhaps to keep him from revealing the names of high-powered politicians, celebrities, and elites who were in his little black book of clients. Due to the alleged suicide, a judge dismissed all criminal charges against him.

Not all of the names in his little black book have been released. Epstein had concealed cameras installed on his private Virgin Island retreat, referred to as Lolita Island, where prominent people flew to allegedly have sex with underage girls. Maxwell helped procure the girls, and Epstein supposedly rented girls to powerful people in order to secretly tape their sexual antics and later blackmail them.

The US Department of Justice, as part of their investigation, found CDs in a locked safe at Epstein’s New York mansion with handwritten labels like

“young (name) + (name).” Epstein told the *New York Times* in 2018 that he had plenty of dirt on some high-profile names regarding their sexual proclivities and drug use.

The list of people who flew in and out of Lolita Island has been made public and is filled with notable actors, rock stars, politicians, bankers, power players, and celebrities, from Bill Clinton to Bill Gates. What we don’t know is what they did when they got to the island or if they were aware of the fact that the island was a hotbed of child sex trafficking.

Some of those names appeared to have flown to the island many times. It’s hard to imagine they didn’t know. Epstein is dead, so he can’t talk, and Maxwell isn’t talking at all.

Epstein’s “suicide” adds to the list of mysterious deaths of people associated with paedophilia and child sex trafficking. Maybe it’s all just coincidence, rumour, and allegation – or maybe beneath the glittery surface of an industry built on dreams is an underworld of nightmares where the young are nothing but objects to be used, abused, and cast away. ■

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
